Summary

This report is designed to help you benchmark the payment performance of your customers and partners against similar businesses in the same industry. It lists the details of 21 key sectors, comprised of over 700 industries by SIC code. We have grouped this report into broad sectors based on two digits SIC code groupings to make it easier for you to identify the key sectors of interest.

This report shows the percentage of invoices paid on time or within terms, then up to 30 days late, up to 60 days, up to 90 days, and beyond 90 days late. We have also included the sector's average number of days beyond terms (DBT) and an indicator as to whether this is improving, stable or worsening.

While the report is not designed to be used as a stand-alone decision-making tool, we recommend that you use the information to benchmark your accounts receivable performance against industry averages to identify potential areas of improvement or update existing credit policies.

Creditsafe relies on contributors to share accounts receivable data as part of our Global Trade Payment Data Programme. Methodology

This report is created by analysing trusted accounts receivable data from Creditsafe customers. In this report, we analysed more than 100 million invoices paid in 2021 & 2022 to identify trends and highlight the typical payment performance of companies within certain sectors and countries.

Key Findings by Sector

- **53%** of invoices paid by the Construction sector were paid late in 2022, up 13% compared to 2021. The average number of days beyond agreed terms (DBT) remained unchanged.
- **48%** of invoices paid by the Manufacturing sector were paid late in 2022, up 6% compared to 2021. The average number of days beyond agreed terms (DBT) rose by two days.
- **46%** of invoices paid by Energy Supply companies were paid late in 2022, up 11% compared to 2021. The average number of days beyond agreed terms (DBT) rose by two days.
- **16%** of invoices paid by the Real Estate companies were paid late in 2022, down 6% compared to 2021. The average number of days beyond agreed terms fell by five days.

Sector Overview

% of late payments by Sector

Across all 21 sectors, on average, 43% of all invoices paid in 2022 were paid beyond agreed terms. Only 3 of 21 sectors saw an improvement in late payments compared to the same period in 2021. The Construction, Health & Social Care, and Hospitality sectors saw the most significant rise in the percentage of late payments compared to 2021.

Days beyond agreed terms (DBT) by Sector

When looking at the average number of days beyond given terms (DBT), we can see that just 9 of the 21 sectors showed signs of year-on-year improvement; of those worsening, the DBT increased by an average of 2 days in 2022 compared to the same period in 2021.

Country Overview

% of Late Payments, and Days Beyond agreed Terms (DBT) by Country

Creditsafe directly collects and shares information on how companies across 9 home countries are paying their suppliers. The below table shows how companies in each of the 9 countries perform in terms of late payments and the average number of days they take to pay invoices beyond agreed terms in 2022 compared to 2021.

Late payments improved across just 4 of the 9 countries in 2022 compared to 2021, and the average number of days taken to pay invoices (beyond agreed terms) declined across five countries.

Although the % of late payments increased by over 8% in the UK, the total number of days beyond agreed terms only increased by 0.43 day(s).

Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing

Companies within this sector grow crops, raise and fatten animals for food products, and grow and harvest timber. Crop producers grow grain, tobacco, vegetables, fruits and nuts.

There are 260 unique SIC codes for Manufacturing. We have grouped them into 24 categories.

Hospitality

Accommodation companies in this sector include; Hotels, holiday and caravan parks, youth hostels and B&B's. Food and beverage companies include; licenced and unlicensed restaurants, cafes, take-away food shops, event catering services, public houses, bars and licenced clubs.

This sector takes an average 29 days to pay its suppliers, with 70% of invoices being paid on time.
